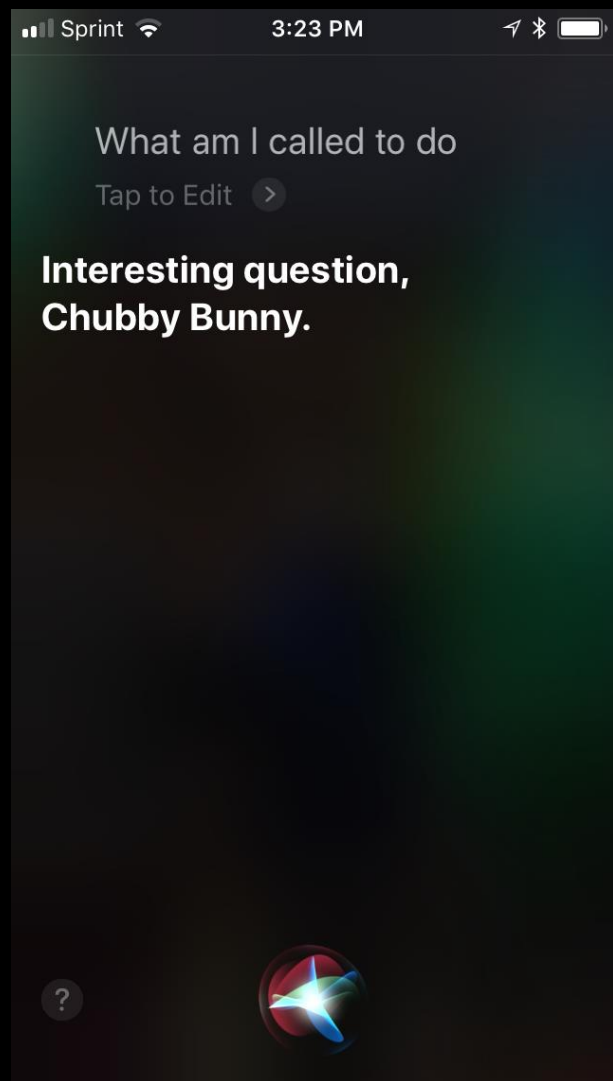
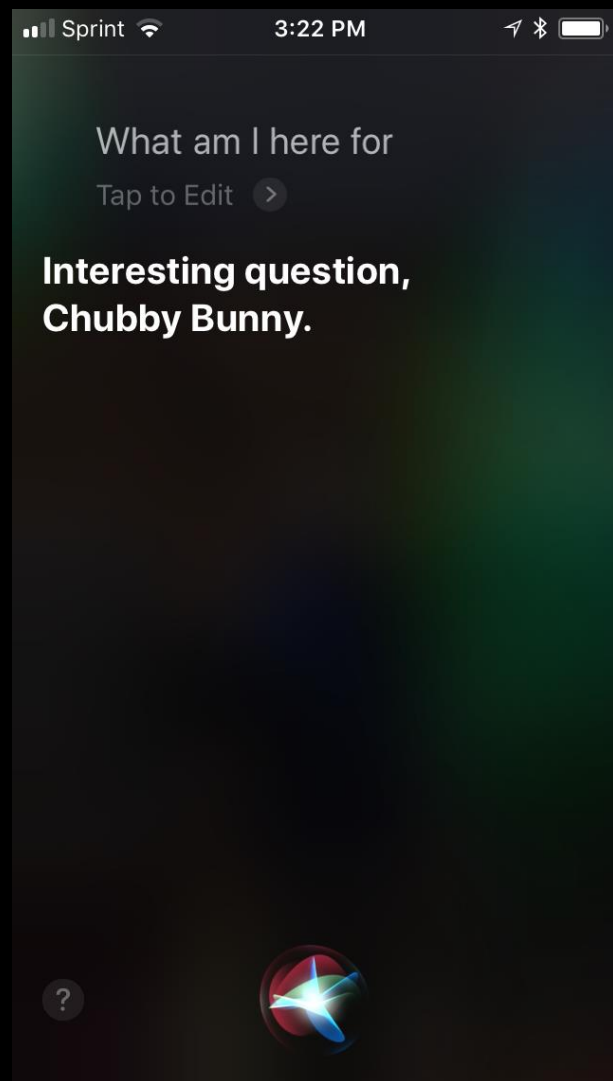

Heidelberg Catechism
